Guest Responsibilities

Contact the professional golf staff at Hickory Valley Golf Club to discuss details for your event at (610) 754-7733.
Select a date for your event and secure your date by returning your Tournament Reservation Agreement along with any applicable deposit.
Finalize food and beverage plans at least ten (10) days in advance.
Guarantee minimum number of participants at least ten (10) days in advance. This number can be adjusted upwards, but not downwards. You will be responsible to pay for 100% of the guaranteed minimum, for golf and for food, if the total number of players falls below the guaranteed number.
Fax or mail the finalized player list and handicaps (if applicable) to the Hickory Valley Golf Club no less than five (5) days before the event.
Please feel free to contact the event staff at the Hickory Valley with any questions or concerns you may have about your outing.
Plan to arrive at minimum one hour in advance of your scheduled event to finalize any outstanding details and to make final payments. <i>Final payments MUST be made prior to your group commencing play</i>

Facility Description

The flagship of Hickory Valley, the Presidential Course combines something new with something old, as the layout incorporates nine of the original 27 holes with a memorable trip through an abandoned nursery over the new nine holes. The Presidential first escorts our guests across wide fairways, large undulating greens and vast array of bunkers, lakes and environmentally sensitive areas.

As you make the turn to the back nine, the course tightens the race just a bit, as the layout meanders through tall mature hardwoods to more smallish greens that require shotmaking with just a hint of clean living. The closing



on the Presidential can be relentless and requiring your undivided attention, as you may be faced with three of the best finishing holes you'll find anywhere.

Come experience for yourself The Presidential and learn why since opening in 1996 the course has received Golf Digest's prestigious 4 star rating.

Although shorter in length at 6,450 yards than its sibling, the elder statesmen



Ambassador more than makes up for it in a classic mature design. What seems benign on the scorecard is not the case, as the routing weaves its way through massive 70 foot high hardwoods to gently rolling greens that slope from back to front. A course for all ages and levels of ability, the Ambassador offers plush conditions throughout and presents its diplomacy with the 610 yard par five 9th hole.

In short the three and half star Ambassador layout should not be taken lightly.

Directions

From Philadelphia:

(Interstates 76W, 476N, 276W Turnpike) Follow interstate to King of Prussia (Route 202 South, take first exit Route 422 west. Proceed to Limerick/Linfield Exit. Turn right off of exit ramp onto Lewis Road, continue approximately two miles to stop light (Ridge Pike). Turn right on Ridge Pike, at first stop light turn left onto Swamp Pike. After crossing Rt 663, proceed approximately 2/3 mile and turn right onto Middlecreek Road. Cross Rt 73 and turn right at T" onto Ludwig Rd – clubhouse is located 1/4 mile on left.

From Allentown:

(Northeast Extension of Turnpike) Follow NE Extension to the Quakertown Exit. Off exit take Route 663 South. Continue on Rt 663 to intersection with route 73.



Turn right on route 73 West, approximately 1/10 of a mile cross over bridge and turn right onto Ludwig Road. Club is 1/4 mile on the right.

From Reading:

Follow Route 422 East to Route 100 North (Pottstown). Continue on Route 100 North until the Gilbertsville/Boyertown Exit (Route 73). Off exit turn right onto Route 73 East, proceed through Gilbertsville. Follow Route 73 makes a severe left hand turn (stop light) at Bermont Motors (vacant property). Proceed 2/3 mile and turn left onto Middlecreek Road. Continue to stop sign, turn right

onto Ludwig Rd clubhouse is located 1/4 mile on left.

From Wilmington/West Chester:

Take Route 100 North through Pottstown. Continue on Route 100 North until the Gilbertsville/Boyertown Exit (Route 73). Off exit turn right onto Route 73 East, proceed through Gilbertsville. Follow Route 73 makes a severe left hand turn

(stop light) at Bermont Motors (vacant property).

Proceed 2/3 mile and turn left onto Middlecreek Rd Continue to stop sign, turn right onto Ludwig Rd Clubhouse is located 1/4 mile on left.
